

Ballot Language from November 7, 2017 election per metro cities in Dallas County:

City	Revenues from the sales and service tax shall be allocated as follows:
Waukee	<p>50% of such revenues to be allocated for property tax relief.</p> <p>50% of such revenues for city quality of life improvement purposes, including but not limited to recreational/sports complexes, community center, trails, parks, arts, cultural amenities, historic preservation, and for other public uses the city deems appropriate.</p>
Grimes	<p>No less than 50% of such revenues to be allocated for property tax relief.</p> <p>The specific purpose for which the revenues will otherwise be expended is: Any lawful purpose of the city.</p>
Clive	<p>50% for property tax relief.</p> <p>50% for capital projects including, but not limited to, street improvements, park and trail improvements, public safety facilities and stormwater improvements.</p>
West Des Moines	<p>50% for property tax reduction.</p> <p>50% of revenue will be applied directly to the construction of public parks, recreational facilities and trails; public infrastructure construction; and public safety expenditures.</p>
Urbandale	<p>50% Property Tax Relief.</p> <p>50% for Specific Purpose: Capital Improvement Projects which may include, but is not limited to, public safety facilities, aquatic center, street improvements, park and trail improvements, stormwater improvements, and related debt retirement.</p>
